Good morning and Happy 1st Sunday of Lent to you. This past Wednesday a good number of the Christian community celebrated Ash Wednesday. To some, it reminded that we rise from ashes because of our Savior. To others it brought closer to the front of their mind the tragedy of our Savior’s suffering.
