

Shalom aleikhem! שלום עליכם Peace be upon you!

Good morning, and welcome! I am grateful you are here as we gather once again to worship our faithful God. Each Sunday is a gift—a time to pause, to refocus our hearts, and to be reminded that the Lord is always at work, often in ways we do not immediately understand. As a church family, let's continue to walk together, trusting God's leading step by step.

Today we continue our journey through **Acts 10**, where Peter follows the Spirit's direction and enters the home of Cornelius. What once would have seemed unthinkable becomes a moment of obedience and humility, as God brings together people from different backgrounds for the sake of the Gospel. This passage reminds us that God often prepares hearts long before we arrive and calls us to trust Him beyond our comfort zones. May our worship today open our hearts to His guidance and remind us that when God leads, He is always working for His greater purpose.
