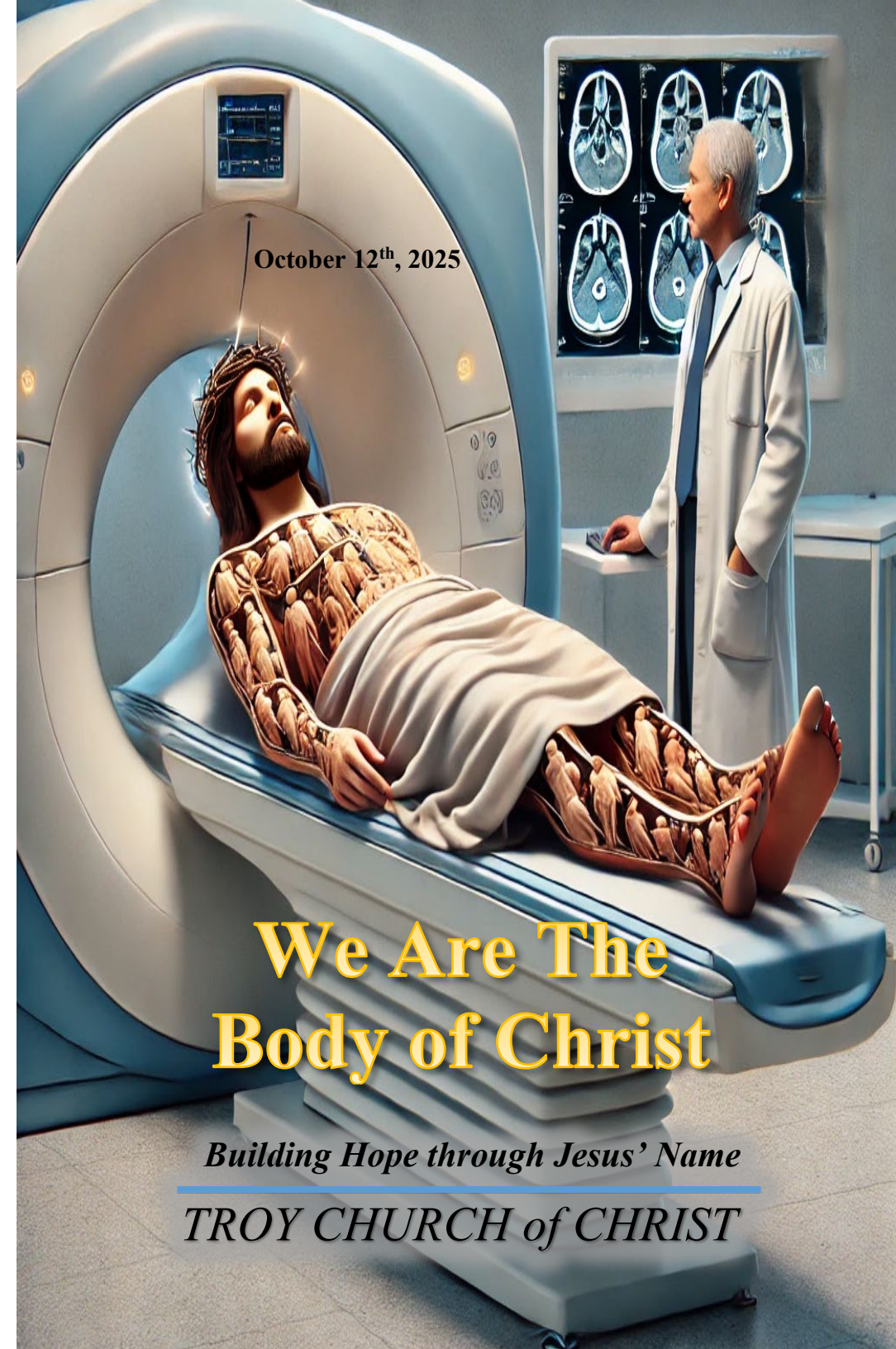

Good morning, and welcome! We’re so thankful you’ve joined us today as we come together to worship our Lord and Savior. Each Sunday reminds us that the church is more than a building—it’s a family of believers, united in faith and bound together by the love of Christ. It is indeed a blessing to lift our voices in praise without fear, to pray for one another, and to grow together in the grace and truth of God’s Word.

Today’s message comes from **Acts 9:4–5**, where Saul hears the voice of Jesus on the road to Damascus: *“Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?”* In that moment, Jesus reveals a profound truth—that His people are His body. To touch the church is to touch Christ Himself. This passage reminds us of how deeply connected we are to our Lord and to one another. May our worship today renew our gratitude for being part of His body and inspire us to live in unity, compassion, and love as His hands and feet in the world.
