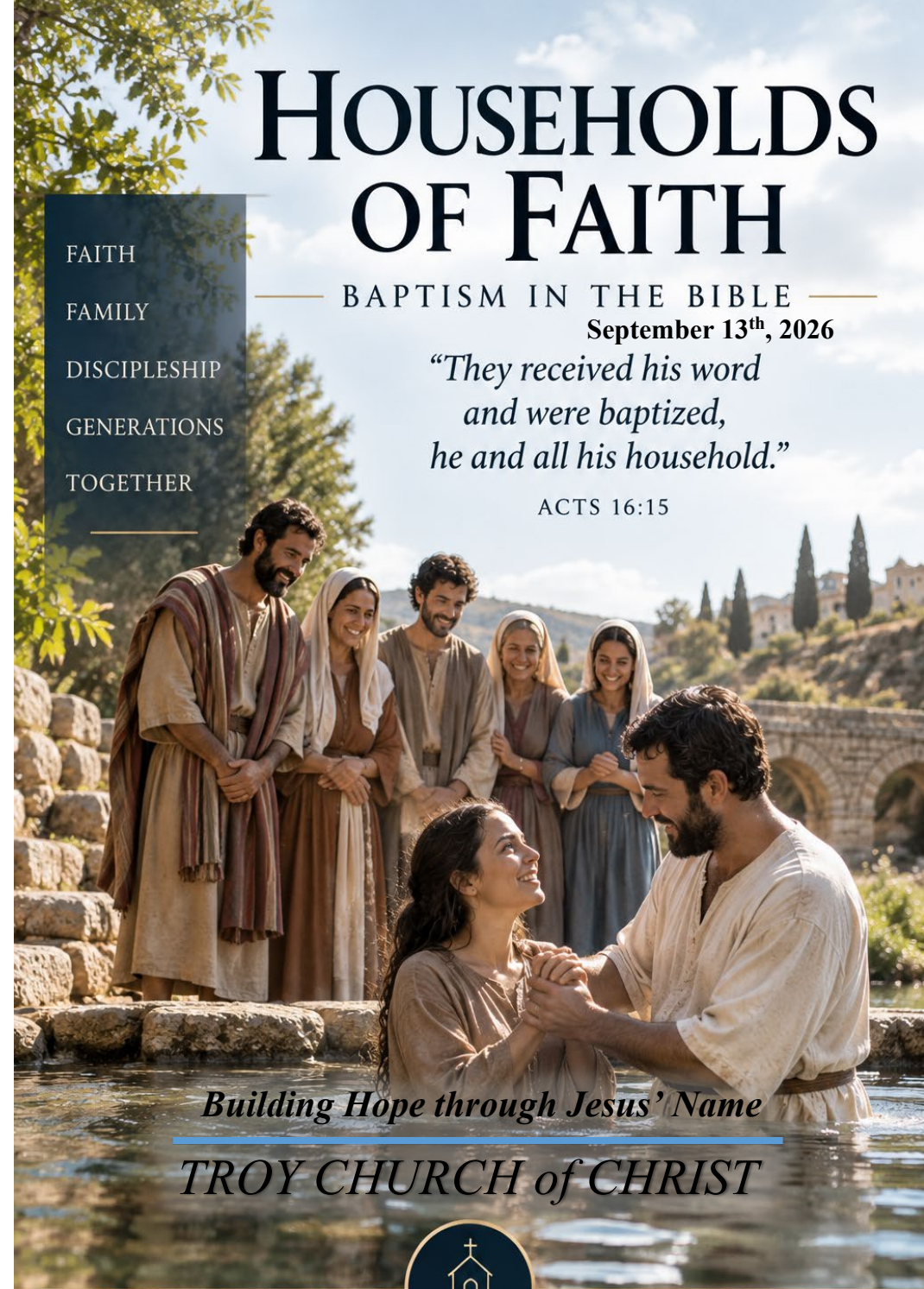

Minister's Corner

Shalom aleikhem! שָׁלוֹם עֲלֵיכֶם Peace be upon you!

Good morning, and welcome! After being away last Sunday, I am grateful to be back with you and excited to continue a conversation we began two weeks ago. Our study of household baptisms reminded us that some biblical questions deserve more than quick answers or inherited assumptions. They deserve careful listening to Scripture, with hearts willing to let God's Word shape what we believe.

This morning we return to the households of Acts and continue asking what these remarkable conversions teach us about families, faith, and baptism. As we look more closely, a distinct pattern emerges: the gospel enters a home, the message is heard and understood, faith takes root, and lives respond in obedience. The emphasis is not merely that entire households were baptized, but that the good news of Jesus reached entire households. What a challenge for our families today! May our homes be places where Christ is spoken about, faith is lived visibly, questions are welcomed, and each generation is lovingly led toward a faith that becomes genuinely their own. May God help us build households where the Gospel is not simply inherited, but heard, believed, and lived.
