Shalom aleikhem! שלום עליכם Peace be upon you!

Good morning, and welcome! I am grateful to gather once again as a church family to worship our faithful God. Every week brings new joys, new challenges, and new opportunities to trust the Lord more deeply. As we sing, pray, and open the Scriptures together today, may we be reminded that God has not left His people to navigate life's difficult questions alone. He has given us His Word, His Spirit, and one another as we seek to walk faithfully before Him.

This morning we continue our journey through the **Book of Acts** as we explore **Acts 15:1–21**. The early church faced a crisis that threatened its unity and struck at the very heart of the gospel: **What is required for salvation?** In the midst of strong opinions and honest disagreement, the apostles and elders sought God's truth together. Their example reminds us that truth matters, grace matters, and unity matters. In a world increasingly divided by ideology, politics, and personal preference, followers of Christ are called to anchor themselves in the gospel and approach one another with both conviction and humility. As we worship today, may God give us hearts that love His truth, extend His grace, and seek the unity that only Christ can provide.
