We observe the Lord's Supper every Sunday as the focal point of our gathering and also take a collection to support the church's work.



One of the greatest challenges of a believer is not the believing part in itself but the relationship. I know many followers of Jesus who have no issue believing or confessing Jesus as Lord, but yet their relationship with Him is no closer today than the day they were baptized. As the only way to be renewed is through the relationship, I believe it to be a continuous struggle for those whose relationship with Christ doesn't reach new depths weekly, to stay renewed in mind and sharp in their focus to worship.
