

After 226 days of imprisonment this Iranian Christian is released. She was initially released temporarily due to the Covid-19 crisis in Iran. Subsequently the prison authorities informed her that she does not have to serve the remaining of her sentence. Thank you for your prayers and remembrance of our brothers and sisters persecuted around the world. Your prayers matter! Next week we will add a new name to our list of three prisoners we are praying for. It will be another Iranian national by the name Yousef Nadarkhani and at this moment he has already been imprisoned for 847 days.
