Shalom aleikhem! שָׁלוֹם עֲלֵיכֶם Peace be upon you!

Good morning, and welcome! I am grateful you're here today as we gather to worship our gracious God. Each Sunday provides the blessing of coming together as His family—lifting our voices in praise, sharing in fellowship, and being renewed by His Word. No matter what this past week has held, I pray that this time together draws your heart closer to the Lord who walks with us every day.

Today we begin **Acts chapter 10** with **verses 1–16**, a powerful section that reveals God preparing something extraordinary. We meet Cornelius, a devout Gentile whose prayers rise before God, and Peter, who receives a vision from heaven that challenges long-held assumptions.
