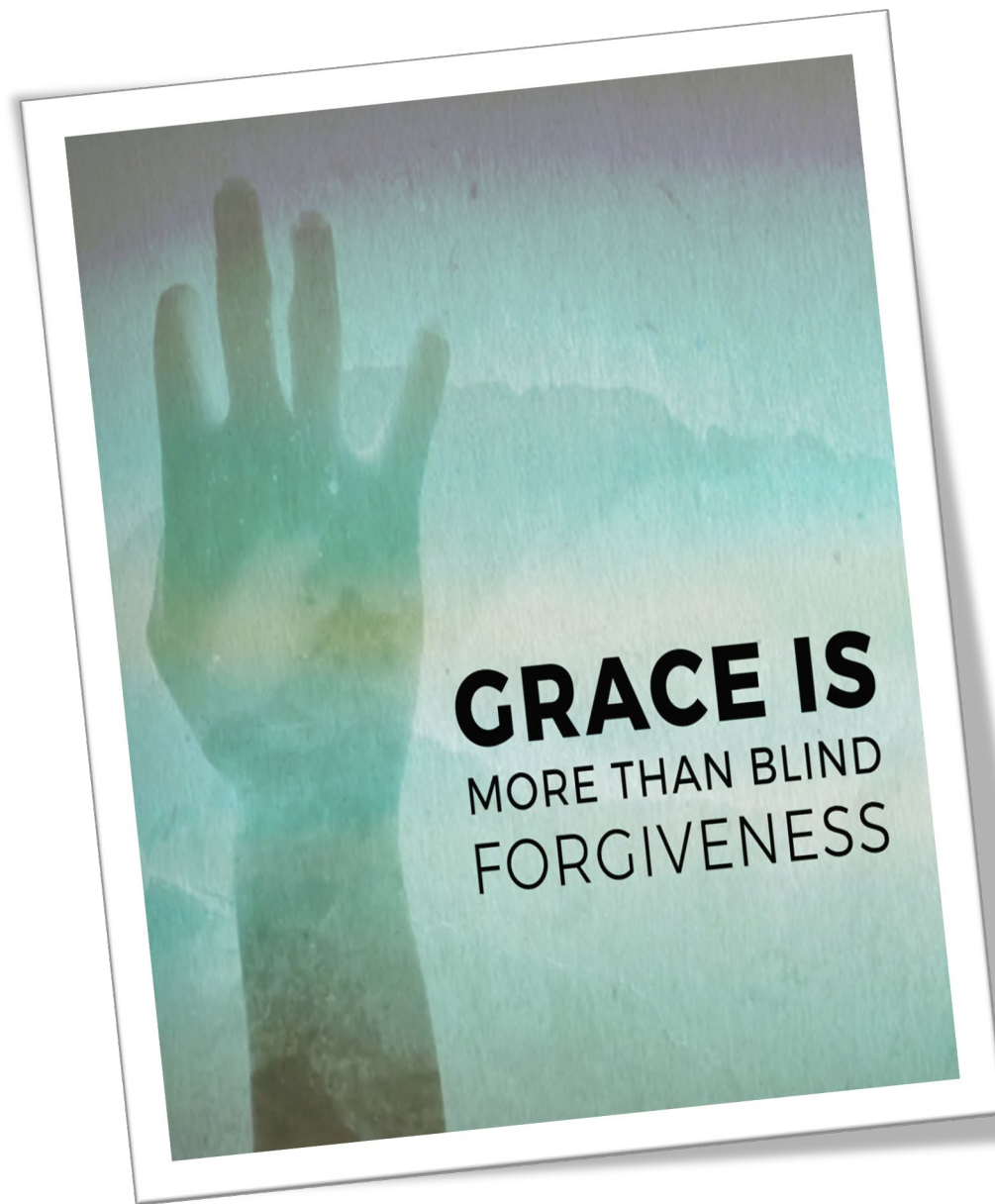

Services at the church building

Thank you to all of you continuing to join us on Zoom. We appreciate so much having you with us! For those of you joining us in person please continue to observe as best you can all the guidelines of health safety as we continue to worship in the building. **We are each responsible for our own health and called to protect those around us as well.** As you may know, due to a rise in Covid-19 cases, the Governor has passed new emergency laws. Law 2020-147 requires individuals older than 5 to wear a mask in indoor public places and states that “*A willful violation of the order is a misdemeanor subject to a \$500 criminal penalty, but no term of confinement may be imposed on individuals who violate the mask requirement. No individual is subject to penalty under the order for removing a mask while engaging in religious worship at a house of religious worship, although consistent with guidance from the CDC, congregants are strongly encouraged to wear face coverings during religious services.*” Thank you.
