Good morning. The Bible tells us that each day is a blessing from God in which His mercies are new, and His steadfast love ever present. (Lamentations 3:22-23). I know however that many mornings I've woken up and it did not feel like a blessing at all. This past Friday, several of us watched the movie Miracles from Heaven, in which there is a scene when a little girl exhausted and depressed by suffering tells her mother that she just wants it all to be over, that she is ready to die.
