

Yousef Nadarkhani – Imprisoned for 854 days

Yousef Nadarkhani and three of his church members, Saheb (Zaman) Fadaee, Mohammad Ali (Yasser) Mosayebzadeh and Mohammad Reza Omidi, are serving 10-year prison sentences on charges of "acting against national security" and "promoting Zionist Christianity." Yousef, 45, had spent nearly three years in prison after being sentenced to death for apostasy in 2010. He was acquitted in September 2012. He was arrested again on Friday, May 13, 2016. Yousef and Fatemeh (wife) were released on bail the same day. Yousef was sentenced in July 2017 and began his sentence a year later in July 2018, after a violent arrest at his home.
