Good morning and blessings to you from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ!

This day is called traditionally Palm Sunday. Palm Sunday marks the beginning of the Holy Week and it celebrates the Triumphal Entry of Jesus in Jerusalem. According to ***Zechariah 9:9***, the King of Israel is prophesized to enter Jerusalem “*on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey*” and this is exactly how Jesus makes His entrance in the Holy City. Messiah, the King of Israel enters Jerusalem fulfilling a prophecy made between 520 and 518 BC, so some five hundred and fifty years before these things actually took place. This shows with clarity that God had made it known since before that the Messiah will not come to overthrow Rome, that He will not be a King as the earthly kings but that He will be a King of Peace. The king of peace between us and God. As we worship today keep this perspective and thank God for His grace!
